

The BROMLEY's VISION 2020 CALENDAR

- 1) The photographs for the 2020 Calendar should reflect the changing community/environment throughout the year.
- 2) Entries are open to individual interpretation but photographs must be taken within the boundaries of Great and Little Bromley.
- 3) Entrants can submit photographs in digital colour or black and white.
- 4) The photographs should be of landscape format and as high a resolution as possible.
- 5) A storage cloud facility will be made available for submission of digital entries.
- 6) Images may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or scratches, but not manipulated.
- 7) The competition is open. Entrants under the age of 14 years need to have parent or guardian consent to enter.
- 8) Each entry should be marked with name, address, contact telephone number (both daytime and evening) and where/when the photo was taken.
- 9) The closing date will be August 1st 2019. This is to allow for judging and printing.
- 10) All entries will be judged by a panel of appropriate independent judges who will consider a range of factors including composition, technical ability, originality, and overall interpretation of the brief.
- 11) The local community shall also be invited to vote for the Finalist they like the best.
- 12) 12 monthly photographs shall appear in The Bromley's VISION 2020 Calendar.

- 13) Each winning photographer will have a Calendar, attributed under their photograph and publicity in the local Gazette and the overall winner will receive a prize.
- 14) Any profit from the selling of the calendars will be distributed to Seven Rivers Leonard Cheshire Disability and Essex Wildlife Trust.
- 15) All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. They must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
- 16) Prior to submission, entrants must not have offered any of their entries for sale, been paid for any publication of any of their entries or won or been a runner up in any other photographic competition with any of their entries.
- 17) Entrants will transfer copyright in the photographs that they submit for the Great Bromley 2020 Calendar. By entering, all entrants grant the Calendar Committee the right to publish and exhibit their photographs on local and social media and website. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses. Entrants whose photographs are one of the Finalists also agree to take part in post-competition publicity.
- 18) By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules.
- 19) The Calendar Committee will be looking for sponsorship from local businesses to advertise on the calendar.
